What if...

What if, for one day, the invisible workers, in the kitchens of restaurants, in the bars, in the stores, in the silence of the houses, would stop?

We all, living with precarious jobs, no contracts, no retirement plans; we, those who have a good school grade, but no one recognize it; we, those who are seen as a danger and an exploitable resource at the same time; we, the people who hear to say "today you don't work, no money". We, those who live blackmailed.

What if we all, at one point, would cross our arms?

The 1st of march will be a national mobilisation day, the first step towards a general strike, in which immigrants workers in this country should loud their voice.

Most of us cannot go on strike, because they work without a contract, they don't have the *permesso di soggiorno* or they are afraid to lose their job. But this day of action could be the time to tell everybody that we exist.

Do not go to work, do not buy anything, organize yourself in the neighbourhood you are living in.

We don't think that precarious jobs are done only by immigrants workers: in Italy there are thousands of workers, Italian or foreigners, that are exploited in several ways; paid 3,50 euro per hour; without any kind of contract; risking to works until 12 hours a day and losing an arm or even their life.

We think that we should stop allowing to be considered as goods. Each one of us.

For all these reasons we have to struggle together in order to make this government recognize our rights as citizens; we want our work and school degree recognized. We want our children, born in Italy, to receive the Italian nationality.

Put all your force and struggle! Trough this way we can reach happiness.
